# Background



- **Pop. Censuses and surveys** in Cambodia: Pop. Count 1921, DS 1946, DS 1958, DS 1959, First Pop. **Census 1962**, Pop. Count 1980, DS 1996, Second Pop. **Census 1998**, CIPS 2004
- There was a census gap of 36 years between **1962** and **1998**.
- The majority of the 1998 General Population Census was supported by UNFPA.
- **2008** Pop.Census is supported by UNFPA, JICA, Japanese Gov't, German Gov't, and RoC.

# Objectives



- Provide basic demographic information such as age, sex, marital status, and key information on household economy, employment, education and health.
- Provide updated and comparative population and development indicators with reference to the 1998 census.

# Objectives (Cont.)



- Provide trends and patterns in fertility, mortality, migration and other demographic and socio-economic variables.
- Provide a sampling frame, from which all other surveys can benefit and extrapolate analysis.
- Establish a comprehensive population database.
- Create awareness between the public at large and senior officials about the importance of high quality data for development planning.

- Dec, 2007 : All preparatory activities for 2008 Census completed,
- March, 2008 : Conduct of National census,
- Aug, 2008 : Preliminary Results,
- Sept, 2009 : Final Results,
- Sept, 2010 : Dissemination of Main Reports Analysis, and Evaluation.

# Tabulation Plan



- From the 67 kinds of tables will be produced.
- About 62, 000 tables by national and sub-national level will be produced.
- Beside the priority tables, a number of the supplementary tables will be produced.
